TREASURERS REPORT:

CHAIRMANS REPORT:

Attached to these minutes. The meeting endorsed the Chairman's comments regarding the problems of adjustments being needed after every round by the adjudicator and stressed that clubs must take more care with regard to swimmers being eligible to compete.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

CHANGE OF RULES:

The secretary reported that Downham were in favour of Ely's proposed cut off times while Cambridge were in favour of the times proposed by Boston. Cambridge was against the proposal by Boston regarding the change of rules for the Junior League finals.

After discussion the votes were as follows:
